## English Instruction

Activities include:

- ▶ Full instruction and surfing in Waikiki
- ▶ Paddle boarding
- ▶ Body boarding
- ▶ North Shore tours, visits and surfing
- ▶ Hike & biking of Diamond Head



Details include:

- ▶ Small group surfing instruction (3 to 4 students per instructor)
- ▶ Additional lessons can be arranged at the school upon arrival – for an additional fee
- ▶ Intended for beginning to intermediate-level surfers
- ▶ All activity related equipment is included
- ▶ Bring your own bathing suit, towels, sneakers etc.
- ▶ Each participant must sign a release form

In addition to all program activities, the ELS Language Center/Honolulu arranges a wide variety of additional activities for students. Some activities are free and others require a small fee. Examples include sightseeing at area Oahu attractions, museum visits, shopping, sporting events and university sponsored events.
